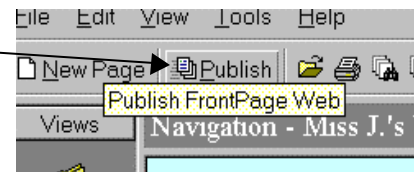
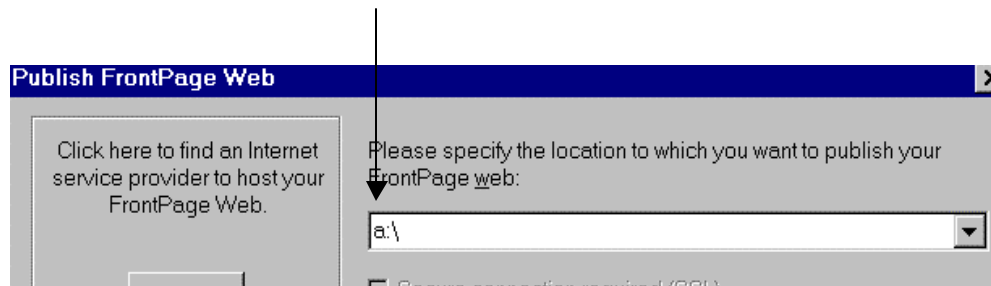


## How to Save Your FrontPage Web to Disk

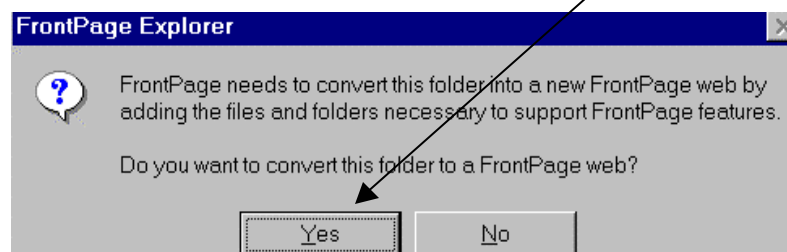
1. First, insert your disk into the floppy drive of your computer.
2. Next, get back into the **Navigation** view of your Web site. (This is the view that lets you see the pages in your Web, their names, and how they're connected. You may have to click the **X** in the upper right-hand corner of the window once or twice to get back to the Navigation view. Be sure to save your work by clicking **OK** if asked.)
3. Click on the **Publish** button on your menu bar.



4. On the **Publish** window that pops up, be sure there is *no* check mark in the box next to the words, "Publish changed pages only."
5. Click on the **More Webs...** button.
6. In the new window that opens, type **a:\** in the box. Click **OK**.



7. In the FrontPage Explorer window that pops up, click **Yes**.



8. You should be able to hear the computer copying your Web page onto your disk. Notice the light by the drive is on, indicating that the drive is in use. It will take quite a long time for the computer to copy your Web (up to ten minutes!). Be patient, and don't worry...nothing is wrong!
9. Be sure to bring your disk back with you to our next FrontPage session!
