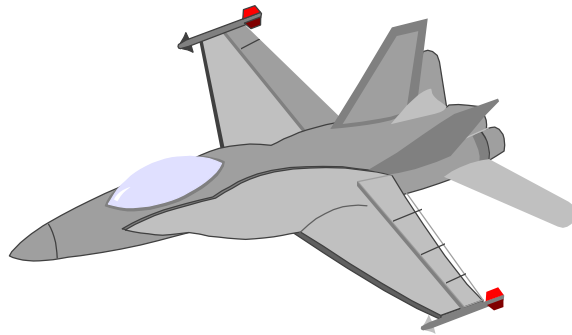


# Map and Globe Task
