

METAMORPHOSIS

Metamorphosis is change. The one constant throughout our lives is that as time goes by and our life experiences accumulate we change – undergo a metamorphosis. Over the next 6 weeks Team **C.A.R.S.O.N** will be exploring metamorphosis across the various disciplines.

In English you will study the Coming of Age; in science you will study force, motion, and simple machines. Social studies will examine revolutions; and Math will focus on fractions and fractals. In each of your classes a metamorphosis will take place.

Your task within your group will be to represent the metamorphosis theme using pictures, symbols, poems, etc. on one large poster. The images must clearly represent a metamorphosis – **Change** – which you and your group have undergone.

All groups must have:

- a concept map

Before moving on to the final phase of the project

- mural

You must work as a group, everyone must participate and have their ideas expressed within the final product. The final product must be as creative as possible. The following rubric will be used for the assessment of the project.
