5) Fill in **questions** that you have in the chapter

Ex. Chapter one says “The Jews of Sighet-that little town in Transylvania-where I spent my childhood...”

You may ask: Where is Transylvania?

6) Fill in **comments** that you want to respond to for this section.

Ex. Chapter two discusses a Madame Schachter who goes crazy on the train. You may want to discuss a time when you saw/or read about a person flipped out somewhere. This is a time to comment on anything you read. Relate it to your life and/or what you’ve read.
