Empathy	Do I seek to understand what others are experiencing and feeling, as well as consider the consequences for others?
Vision	Do I have a deep understanding of where we, as a classroom or school, are headed?
Confidence	Do I believe I have the skills and wherewithal to achieve my goals?
Courage	Do I face challenges directly?
Systems Thinking	Do I seek to discern how all of the aspects of a classroom or organization are interconnected?
Integrity	Do I thrive in honesty and stand by my word?
Intuition	Do I pause to gain a sense of how I feel about a situation before taking action?
