- ❑ **Designing *Learner-Active, Technology-Infused Classrooms (LATIC)*** entails a comprehensive look at classroom design to produce the ultimate learning environment that promotes student engagement, empowerment, and efficacy — whether students are learning fully in school or at home. This multi-year engagement in deepening educators' understanding of designing instruction:
 - ❑ Engages and motivates students through problem-based learning that depends on a series of paradigm shifts that develop across the years.
 - ❑ Provides students with carefully designed structures to take responsibility for their own learning, including self-assessment, reflection, and self-advocacy.
 - ❑ Positions the teacher to ensure learning for all through personalized facilitation.

Logistics

- Teachers attend 8 days of summer training, receive job-embedded support throughout the school year, and become the force of change for shifting the pedagogy of a school.
- Fees are based on the number of teachers.
- The summer PL experience will be conducted either as a fully on-site experience, a fully remote experience, or a hybrid experience, based on the district's needs. The workshop days run from 9:00 AM until 3:00 PM.

- The summer PL experience will be conducted using a learning platform of the district's choice (e.g., Office 365, OneDrive, and Teams; GSuite, Google Classroom, and Hangouts or Zoom; Schoology; CANVAS; and any combination thereof).
- Participating teachers will need a copy of the relevant grade-level edition of the book *Students Taking Charge* (2018 version) and *Reinventing the Classroom: Learning Anywhere, Anytime*. (Dr. Sulla's publisher is currently providing a 50% discount on the purchase of both books.)

□ ***Reinventing the Classroom Experience; Learning Anywhere Anytime*** is addressed through professional learning based on Dr. Sulla's latest book of the same title, inspired by the need for teachers to implement classroom structures and strategies that work as well at home as they do in school — thus eliminating the need to shift teaching strategies when shifting venues. The professional learning experience allows educators to explore critical components of their own classroom instruction in terms of what the COVID-19 pandemic taught us for building academic resilience and minimizing learning loss. Participants will explore and adopt structures and strategies that meet their needs in all of these areas:

□ **Leadership Summits** are powerful and much-needed summer experiences to inspire, energize, and outfit school and district leaders for a new school year. Whatever the district's goals, successes, or challenges, the summit can expand collaboration and innovative thinking to chart a pathway for a more powerful future. Author Tanya Bosco uses her 10 mindsets of leadership to tackle new ideas, encourage reflection, and build the leadership repertoire for moving forward toward their collective and individual goals. The fee is \$4,000 for the day, which can be broken into half-day increments for the convenience of scheduling with building administrators.

The fee is \$2,010 per consultant per day for a group of up to 20 teachers.

- ❑ **A Keynote Presentation by Dr. Nancy Sulla** gives your school/district/organization the gift of inspiration and practical ideas through a one- to two-hour keynote presentation followed by optional Q&A breakout sessions. Engaging, innovative, and practical, Dr. Sulla consistently wows her audiences and leaves them with strategies they can immediately implement in the classroom.
